Training & Consulting: Fellowship

The Fellowship program includes:

Medical office activity

- > First visit and anamnesis
- > Infertility research
- > Delivery of information to patients; communication of results
- > Decision-making process
- > Management of controlled ovarian stimulation procedures and follow-up
- > Ultrasound for investigation and diagnosis of infertility
- > Ultrasound for monitoring the follicle and preparation of the endometrium
- > 3D ultrasound to evaluate the uterine cavity
- > Appointment after a negative pregnancy test
- > Exchange of information with a multidisciplinary team (Immunology, Endocrinology, Obstetrics, minimally invasive surgery, etc.)
- * > Artificial insemination (Training to perform the technique. You could perform this procedure on selected patients with whom you have established a doctor-patient bond, and the patient accepts it.)
- > Ovarian rejuvenation

Oocyte pick-up

- * > Clinical practical training in follicular puncture

Embryo transfer

- > Visit of the embryo transfer rooms
- > Providing information to patients about embryology and transfer
- * > Embryo transfer process (Training to perform the technique: mock transfer. You could perform this procedure on selected patients with whom you have established a doctor-patient bond, and the patient accepts it.)
- * > Ultrasound to guide embryo transfer

Surgical activities

- * > Hysteroscopy related to infertility: diagnostic hysteroscopy procedure (Based on the development of the fellow and his commitment to the surgical team, the technique could be performed)
- > Summary and discussion of the results
- * > Myomectomy (You would not perform the technique, but you could be an assistant as a second surgeon)
- * > Laparoscopy (You would not perform the technique, but you could be an assistant as a second surgeon)
